SANCTIONS UNDER NEBRASKA LAW FOR UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OR DISTRIBUTION OF ILLICIT DRUGS**

Methamphetamine "Meth" or "Speed" Schedule II(c)(3)	Any detectable amount up to 10 grams	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class II felony.
	At least 10 grams but less than 28 grams	Class IV felony.
	At least 28 grams but less than 140 grams	Not less than 3 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class ID felony.
	140 grams	Not less than 5 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class IC felony.
	140 grams or more	Not less than 20 years imprisonment and not more than life imprisonment. Class IB felony.
Heroin Schedule I(b)(11)	Any detectable amount up to 10 grams	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class II felony.
	At least 10 grams but less than 28 grams	Class IV felony.
	At least 28 grams but less than 140 grams	Not less than 3 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class ID felony.
	140 grams	Not less than 5 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class IC felony.
	140 grams or more	Not less than 20 years imprisonment and not more than life imprisonment. Class IB felony.
Cocaine or Base Cocaine "Crack Cocaine" Schedule II(a)(4)	Any detectable amount up to 10 grams	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class II felony.
	At least 10 grams but less than 28 grams	Class IV felony.
	At least 28 grams but less than 140 grams	Not less than 3 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class ID felony.
	140 grams	Not less than 5 years imprisonment and not more than 50 years imprisonment. Class IC felony.
	140 grams or more	Not less than 20 years imprisonment and not more than life imprisonment. Class IB felony.
Phencyclidine "PCP" or "Angel Dust" Schedule II(d)(4)	Any detectable amount	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class II felony.
	Any detectable amount	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class IV felony.
	Any detectable amount	Up to 4 years imprisonment and 9-24 months post-release supervision or \$25,000 fine or both. Class III felony.
	Any detectable amount	Up to 2 years imprisonment and 9-12 months post-release supervision or \$10,000 fine or both. Class I felony.

	Any Controlled Substances classified in Schedule IV or V	Any detectable amount
