

Timely Warning – Motor Vehicle Theft

Dear Campus Community,

The following information is being shared to enhance your personal safety at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

A timely warning is being issued in connection to motor vehicle thefts.

The University of Nebraska-Lincoln Police Department is investigating multiple reports of motor vehicle thefts on both City and East Campus. The first theft occurred October 9, 2019, and two others occurred November 1, 2019. All three occurred between 6:30 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.

Locations of the thefts: Parking Garage – 14th/Avery; Parking Lots – 4000 East Campus Loop and 615 N. 19th Street

In each incident, the suspect(s) attempted to open numerous handles on other vehicles until finding doors that were unlocked. The suspect(s) have not been identified.

UNLPD would like to remind the campus community to refrain from keeping items of any value inside vehicles, and if you must keep them inside your car, make sure they are hidden from view, make certain all doors are locked before leaving a parked vehicle, and always keep vehicle keys secured.
